


This guidebook focuses on the 'Communicate Online' competency, where you will learn:

Cyber Security Tips

To stay safe while using instant messaging apps, please keep to the following:



Do not open or download any unverified links or attachments from unknown sources.



Do not share personal or financial details, passwords or one-time password (OTP) with anyone.



Block unknown users that send you unsolicited chats.



Enable two-factor (2FA) authentication.



Check for updates and update your app promptly to protect your devices from known security vulnerabilities.



Download apps from **official** sources.

About Instant Messaging

Instant Messaging (IM) apps, such as WhatsApp and Telegram, allow calls and exchanges of real-time messages and files over the Internet. Communication on instant messaging apps is usually amongst known users.


With instant messaging, people can stay connected globally by sending messages and making calls as long as there's Internet connection.

Pre-requisites to learning the app

Learners must:

- Have a mobile device (either iOS or Android) connected to either cellular network or Wi-Fi with a working camera.
- Know how to install an app on the mobile device.
- Have a smartphone (iOS/Android) available for WhatsApp use with your iPad.

Note: There is no WhatsApp for iPad. However, you can use WhatsApp Web on iPad by linking your WhatsApp on your iPhone/Android phone to iPad's WhatsApp Web.


Go to "Account" under "Settings" and select "Two-step verification".

- **Turn on Two-step** verification Two-step verification *** For extra security, turn on two-step verification, which will require a PIN when registering your phone number with WhatsApp again. Turn on
- Tap "Turn on" and follow the in-app instructions to generate a 6-digit PIN. Optionally, you can add an email for PIN recovery in the event of forgetting. Tap "Skip" if you prefer not to add an email.
- **Two-step verification Activated** Two-step verification Two-step verification is on. You'll need to enter your PIN if you register your phone number on WhatsApp again. Turn off Change PIN Change email address

Tap **"Done"** to activate Two-step verification.









Block and Report Chat

Block/Report Sender NOT in Your Contact List







Tap on "Block" to prevent the contact from calling or sending you messages, and your chat will be deleted from WhatsApp.


Tap on "Block and report" to forward the last 5 messages to WhatsApp for review, and the contact will be automatically blocked afterwards.


Tap on the three-dot menu, then tap on "More". Select "Report" or "Block". Tap on "Report".







Tap on "Delete my account", enter your phone number in full international format and tap on "Delete my account". For Android devices, you need to select a reason and then tap on "Delete my account".


Note: Deleting your WhatsApp account will:

- Delete your account from WhatsApp.
- Erase your message history.
- Delete you from all of your WhatsApp groups.
- Delete your message history backup.


