



This image is a broad guideline on where the buttons and switches are usually located. Please note this may differ across different mobile devices and models.






Please take note:


There are recent scams involving QR codes being encoded with a fake link to direct users to fake websites that require login details.

- Do not scan QR codes in the form of stickers or flyers placed randomly in public places, especially if they offer youchers or discounts.
- Use a QR code scanner that displays the link that the QR code leads to, allowing you to check if you are accessing the correct link.
- Do not key in any personal or financial information if the QR code leads you to a website that asks you to fill in your name, phone number etc.

This icon shows that the mobile device is **charging**.





