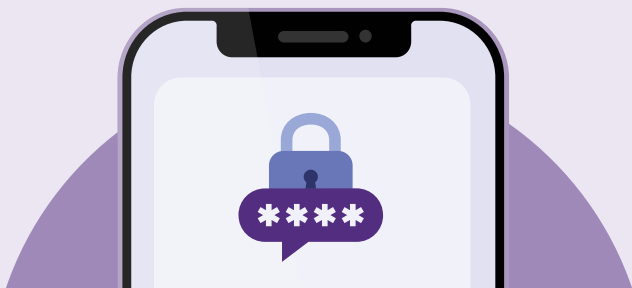

To stay safe while using digital learning apps, please keep to the following:



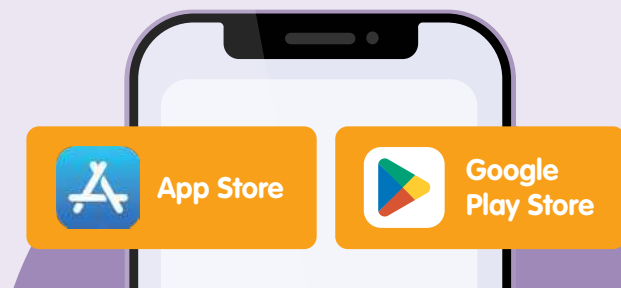
Do not disclose your Singpass login details to others as it can lead to unauthorised access to your accounts and personal information.

Check for updates and **update your app promptly** to protect your devices from known security vulnerabilities.



Download apps from **official** sources.

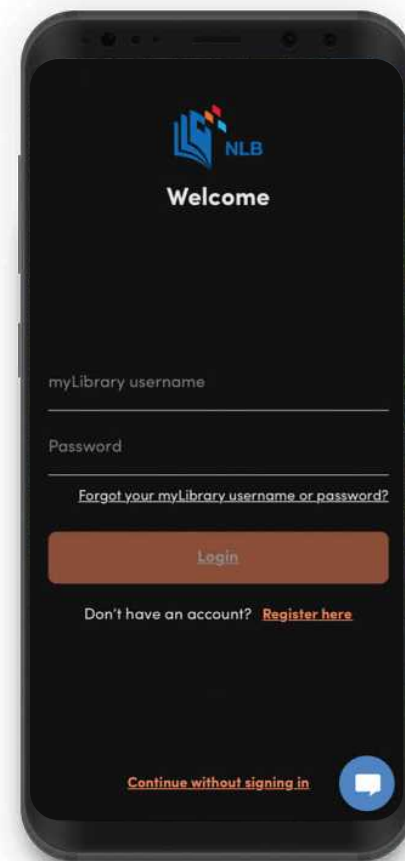
About Digital Learning Apps

Find eBook and Audiobook titles.



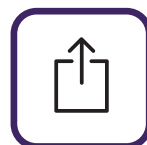
More Icon

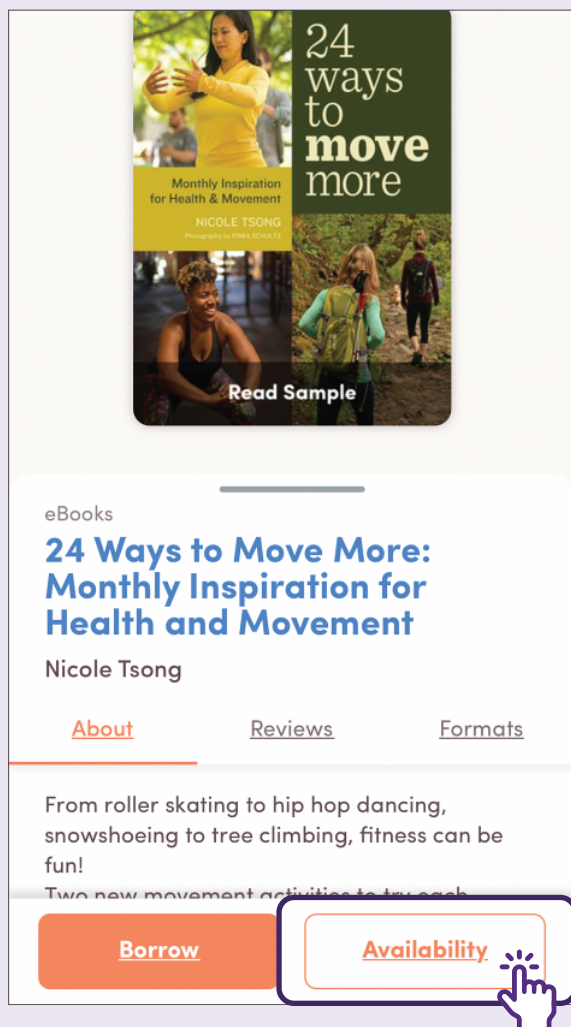

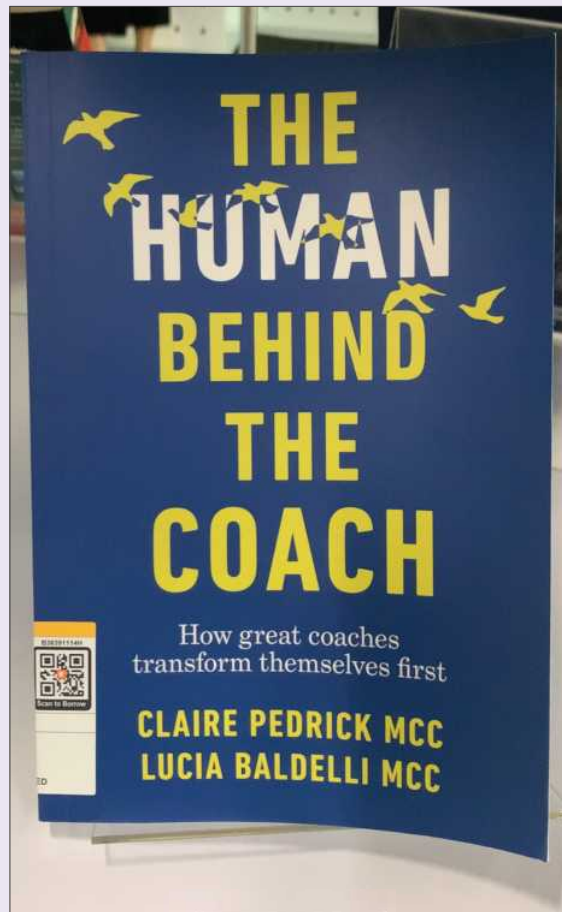

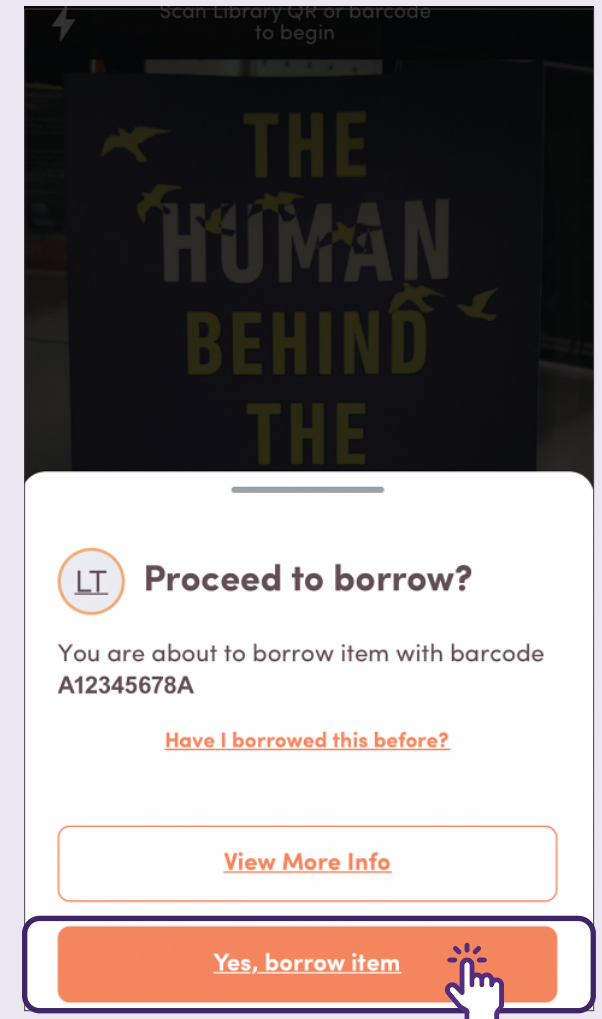

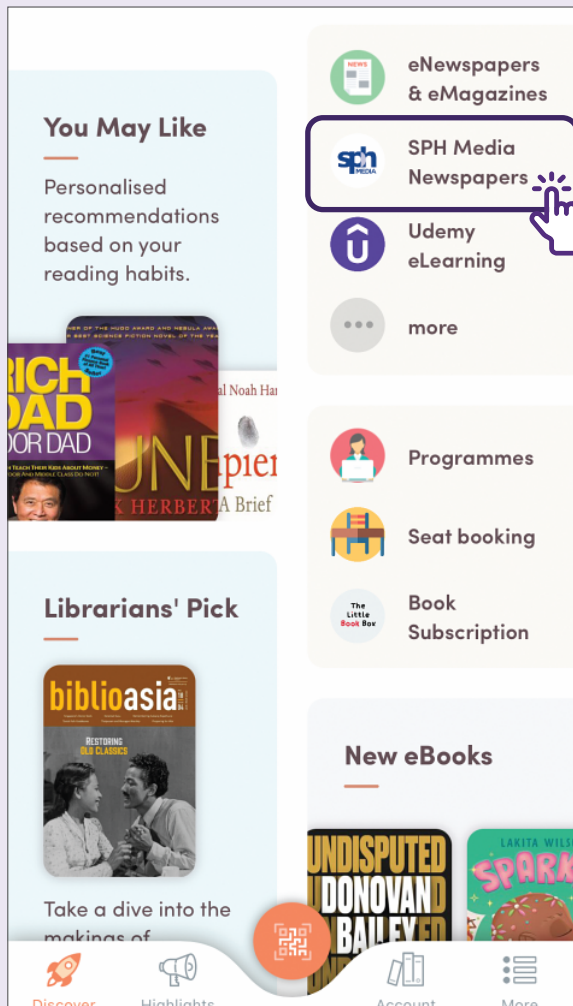
