DID YOU KNOW?

With PayNow, you can send and receive Singapore Dollar funds from one bank to another in Singapore almost instantly by using just your registered mobile number or Singapore NRIC/FIN.

STEP 1 Install your preferred bank app on your mobile device

Go to the **Apple App Store**  or **Google Play Store**  to download any of the bank apps supported under PayNow and launch the application.

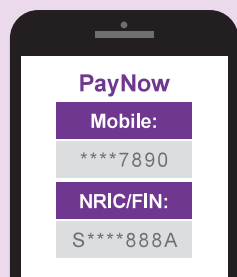

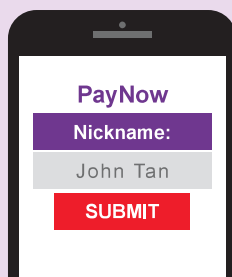
You will need to install and activate internet banking for your bank account prior to setting up PayNow.

Assistance is available (if required) over the counter at the nearest banking branch.

STEP 2 Link PayNow to your bank account



1. Launch your preferred bank app and link your mobile number and/or Singapore NRIC/FIN.



2. Enter a nickname for your PayNow account, avoid using your full name, to help others identify who you are on PayNow.

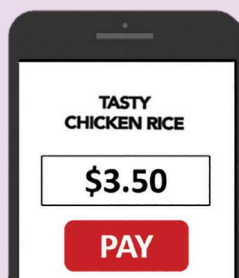

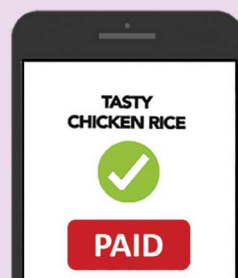

4. Scan the PayNow QR displayed by the merchant and check the merchant name.



5. Enter the transaction amount and verify the merchant name on your mobile phone before you proceed with the payment.



6. You will receive a payment notification message. The amount is immediately deducted from your bank account and credited to the merchant.

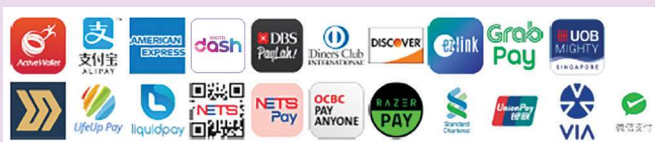
DID YOU KNOW?

SGQR is a single payment QR code that combines the QR codes of different electronic payment schemes. Consumers just need to look at the bottom of the SGQR label to see which payment option is accepted by the merchant.

STEP 1 Install your preferred mobile payment app on your mobile phone

Go to the **Apple App Store**  or **Google Play Store**  to download any of the payments apps supported under SGQR and launch the application.

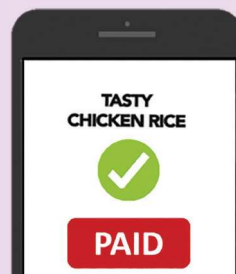
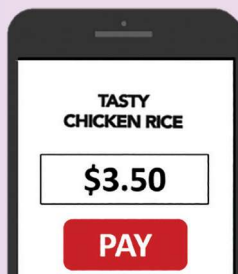
STEP 2 Scan SGQR and make payment

1. Launch your preferred payment app's built-in QR code scanner to capture the SGQR.



2. Scan the SGQR displayed by the merchant and check the merchant name.

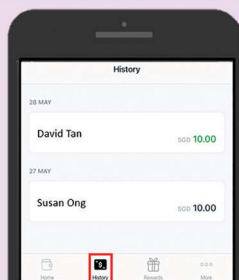
3. Enter the transaction amount and verify the merchant name in your mobile phone before proceeding with the payment.



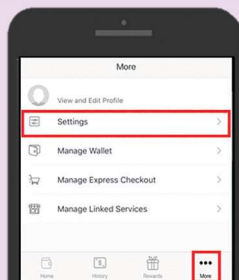
4. You will receive a payment notification message. The amount is immediately deducted from your e-wallet/account and credited to the merchant.

Note: Steps to scan SGQR and make payment will vary for different payment apps.

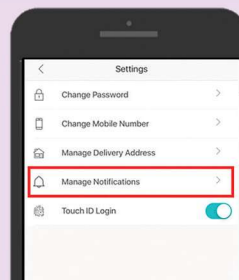

5. Tap on 'History' to view your transaction history.



6. Tap on 'More', 'Settings' to manage notifications.



7. Tap on 'Manage Notifications' to manage alerts and notifications for transactions.

Note: Steps to view transaction history and manage notifications will vary for different payment apps.

8. Tap on the 'Get Coupon Code' to reveal promo code to redeem through the app.



9. Some merchants will require you to input their for 4-digit merchant code to redeem.



10. You can also redeem 1-for-1 dining from the app too!

- Use a **strong password** on your device to prevent unauthorised use.
- Change your **password regularly** to reduce the risk of having your online account compromised.

DID YOU KNOW?

You share personal data with every transaction or online interaction you make. As such, you should be aware of ways that can ensure your personal data is being well-managed. Here is a checklist to help you manage your data responsibly.

STEP 1

Transact with accountable organisations



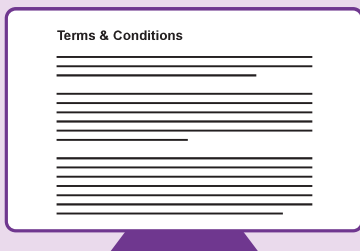
Transact with organisations that you can trust to take care of your personal data.

Look out for organisations that display the Data Protection Trustmark (DPTM) logo for added assurance that your personal data will be kept safe. DPTM-certified organisations have accountable data protection practices to better safeguard your personal data.

STEP 2

Read through the Terms & Conditions



Websites are required to provide information about what personal data is being collected and why in their data protection or privacy policy. Mobile applications also provide similar information and are required to seek your consent before you download the app.

Take your time to read through the terms and conditions to better understand what data they are collecting from you, and how your data is being managed.

STEP 3

Take swift and immediate action to protect your data



Organisations are required to inform you if a data breach has occurred and may result in any risk or harm to you. When that occurs, you should follow the necessary steps advised by the organisation to manage your personal data, such as changing your passwords, or contacting your bank or financial institution to protect yourself from unknown charges.

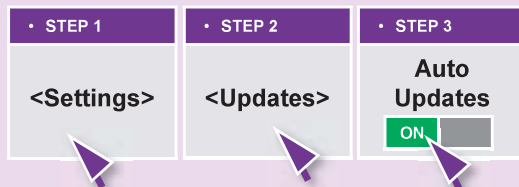
DID YOU KNOW?

Just as we lock our doors to keep burglars out, we must learn how to secure our devices and manage our information when transacting online. Here is a checklist to help you stay safe online.

1 Use an anti-virus software and update it regularly



Anti-virus software can scan and remove harmful viruses, and block unsafe websites. Be wary of fake anti-virus apps and only install apps from official app stores.



Software updates keep your computer and devices safe from security threats. Enable automatic updates if the option is available.

2 Share your personal data with care

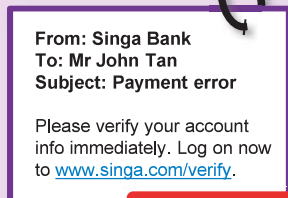


When sharing your personal data online, always

- Find out why you are being asked for your data; and
- Think about whether it is necessary to provide it before you do.

If you are unsure why the requested information is necessary, always seek further clarification from the organisation to better understand how your data will be used.

3 Spot signs of phishing

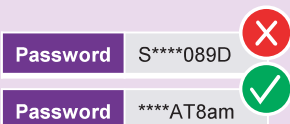

Phishing is used by scammers to trick you to give them your personal or financial information such as login details, bank account and credit card numbers.

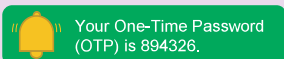
Beware of fake websites, emails or phone messages claiming to be from the government or service providers. Look out for misleading information. Be careful of urgent and unexpected requests for your confidential information in exchange for attractive rewards. Do not open or download any unverified links or attachments.

4 Use strong passwords and enable 2FA



Create long and random passwords by using '5 different words' that you can remember (e.g. IhadKAYAt toastAT8am).

Do not reveal your password and One-Time Password (OTP) to anyone or unknown websites. When available, enable 2-factor authentication (2FA) as an additional layer of verification.

5 Check, before we share

HOW TO SPOT A SCAM?

Signs of Scams

01. Immediate Payment

- ▶ Caller threatens to take action if money is not transferred immediately.

02. Request for Personal Information

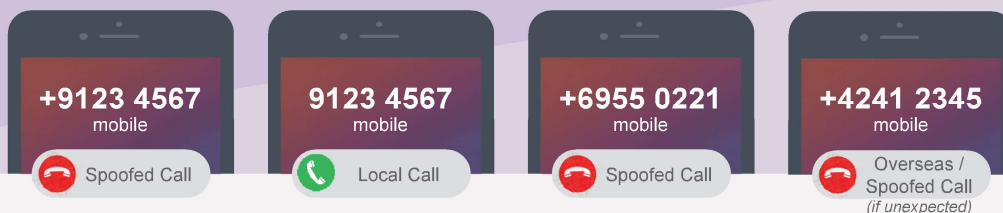
- ▶ Caller identifies himself as a government official or from a legitimate business and asks for your personal information such as bank details and NRIC number for the purpose of investigation in order to absolve yourself from any criminal offence.

03. Don't Tell Others

- ▶ You are warned to keep the call a secret.

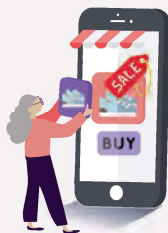
04. "+" Sign Prefix

- ▶ Seeing what seems like a local number with a "+" prefix is likely to be a spoofed call. Only incoming international calls have the "+" sign prefix displayed whilst local calls will not have a "+" prefix.



Common Scams

E-Commerce Scam



Scammers typically tout low prices for their merchandise and request you to make payment in advance.

Social Media Impersonation Scam



Scammers often use compromised / spoofed social media accounts posing as your family members or friends to obtain your personal information.

Loan Scam



Scammers pretend to be a staff from a licensed moneylender and typically send a SMS text or WhatsApp message offering loan services.

What should you do:

01. If unsure, call the NCPC Anti-Scam hotline at **1800-722-6688** (9am – 5pm, Mon – Fri) or email hotline@ncpc.org.sg.
02. Never give personal information and One-Time Passwords (OTPs) over the phone. Always **verify with the organization's main hotline** and not through the contact details given in the suspected call.
03. For unexpected calls showing a "+" prefix, it is an incoming international call. **Exercise greater caution** when answering them.

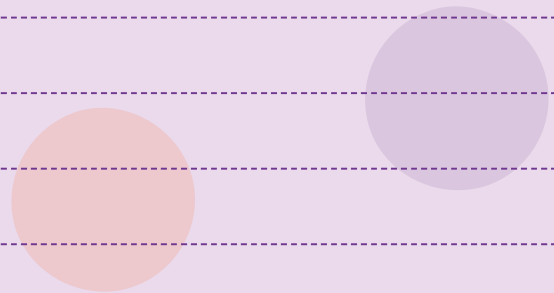
